*Australia is the only Commonwealth country that does not have a treaty with its First Nations Peoples. Colonisation, assimilation, and ongoing attacks on self-determination, culture, languages, and lands creates urgency in calls for treaty from first nations Australians. This year's lecture will raise these issues from the perspective of legal justice.*

*Wiri man Tony McAvoy SC – appointed Senior Counsel in 2015 – has developed a strong native title practice and has successfully appeared for claimants in several land claims. He has also acquired significant*
